

History & Stats: The Nordic Hedge Award

Stockholm (HedgeNordic) – With this year's event, the Nordic Hedge Award is going into its seventh year. This gives us some history and data to analyze and see if there are patterns or evident (performance) requirements among the winners. Unlike many other industry awards though, the Nordic Hedge Awards are not a result of pure data-driven scrutiny but are rather ultimately ranked as a result of an equal-weighted quantitative and qualitative scoring model, where the view of a jury of industry professionals contributes to the overall scoring.
